Brickwork release 5.17

New Features

- Correct bug in which Direct Debit Reference number not populating correctly on the iATS Customer Code when using Rapidata processor.
- Modify Download Journal code to accommodate for new XML formatting within Smart Debit Direct Debit ADDACS BACS report import.
- Correct bug related to ACH Customer Code batch updates removing payment data in certain circumstances.
- New Payer fields added to iATS Customer Code record to accommodate for updating via Batch:
 - Payer First Name
 - Payer Last Name
 - Payer Email
 - Payer Address
 - Payer City
 - Payer State
 - Payer Zip Code
 - Payer Country
- New Brickwork Report “iATS Batch Update CCode Template” has been added to the Brickwork Reports Folder which includes the new Payer fields listed above. ACH and CC payment fields have been removed from the template as those fields cannot be updated via batch at this time. The original report template will be deprecated in a future version.

Action Items

- New iATS Customer Code payer fields will need to be manually added to the page layout.
 - From Salesforce Setup, locate the iATS Customer Code object (using object manager in Lightning, or via Objects in Classic).
 - Edit the page layout.
 - Add the new fields to the page layout and optionally in a new section called “Payer Details”.
- There are no changes to the NPSP Recurring Donation or Payments extensions.

Action Items (Optional)

- By default, ACH Single Transactions are posted to Salesforce immediately with a transaction status of OK:55555 and a related Opportunity Stage of your “closed won” option determined in iATS Settings.
By enabling the new options for “Stage if iATS Transaction is Pending”, Brickwork will mark the related Opportunity Stage to an “open” value of your choice. Once the iATS Transaction Status field is updated to reflect the proper Approval or Rejection Status, the Opportunity Stage will be automatically updated to the “closed won” stage.

- If you wish to reduce the batch size of your iATS Download Journal import (manual or scheduled), this is done in Custom Settings (Path to adjust field: Setup > Develop > Custom Settings > IATS Brickwork Settings > Manage > Edit > Journal Download Batch Size field).
Please note that the maximum size is 200 and minimum is 1. Any values over or under will be discarded and the default 200 batch size will be set.
This update is not recommended unless you are receiving NPSP errors related to batch sizes.

- Automatic iATS Customer Code and Contact relating - When you use the Brickwork VT to create a new recurring token, you no longer need to relate the Customer Code and Contact records together manually. Brickwork will automatically relate the Customer Code to the “Primary” contact role on the Opty.
- Rejected recurring Payment records marked as Written Off – There is a new option to have rejected iATS Transactions update the NPSP 'written off' checkbox when using our NPSP Payments integration. Optionally enabled via iATS Settings.
- Manual re-post option within Aura Post Error Emails – Should you receive an Aura post error message indicating the Aura donation information wasn't posted to Salesforce properly, once the issue has been addressed you can now force the “post” to Brickwork to happen again by clicking the URL at the bottom of the error message.
- Various bug fixes and improvements.

Action Items

- If you are using Brickwork with the NPSP Payment records, you can optionally enable the new “Update Rejected Transaction Payment to Written Off” feature within the iATS Settings Tab.
